Pistachio displays mind-blowing petal colors of lime green accented by deep pink. This unique reblooming mophead blooms from late spring to fall and will be the center piece of your garden and the talk of the town. Need more buzz? Acidify the soil and watch flower centers pop with gorgeous purple-blue tones.

Pistachio Hydrangea is a compact mophead cultivar. It typically blooms on old wood (flower buds are produced the previous fall and overwintered) in late spring with a repeat bloom on new wood from summer often into fall if spent flowers are regularly deadheaded.
