Ever-changing color

This shrubby Japanese maple puts on a spectacular color show through the season. Yellow spring foliage quickly develops a pink margin, then shifts to white and reddish-orange in summer. In fall the leaves transform to orange-red and ultimately red-violet. All of this color is held on dissected leaves with an appealing texture.

- Prefers moist, well-drained soil
- Prune late winter / early spring
- Specimen, woodland gardens
